Bodegas Riojanas 'Viña Albina' Gran Reserva DOCa

Bin #700 Bodegas Riojanas 2001 Tempranillo Rioja, Spain \$95 "Rusty and mature in color, with earthy, lightly leafy aromas that come with notes of maple and brown sugar. This feels elegant and fit, with classic Rioja flavors of dried red fruit, cocoa and malt. The finish is long and tasting lightly baked." 90 pts. – Wine Enthusiast



Abelis Carthago 'Lui Selection' Toro Crianza

Bin #701 Abelis Carthago 2008 Tempranillo Toro, Spain \$70 Dark, tight, and charred on the nose with intense berry aromas. The palate is quite juicy and acidic for Toro, with potent black fruit and cocoa flavors. The wine's primed acidity lasts onto the finish, creating length and raciness.



Ventoso Vines 'Bobal

Bin #702 Vitivinos Winery 2012 Bobal Mancheula, Spain \$48 An appealing bright, inky purple color Ventoso Vines is a vibrant wine of body and well-balanced acidity. An aromatic nose brings fresh black fruits to mind. Fruity, flowery flavors follow, accompanied by hints of a brief passing through oak.



Raimat Tempranillo

Bin #703 Castell de Raimat 2013 Tempranillo Catalonia, Spain \$38 An ideal wine for a variety of meals, given the balance it strikes between acidity, fruitiness, and complexity. This perfect combination evokes cherry, licorice, fresh grass, cedar, tobacco, and spices with flavors that are a delight to the palate. The grapes from which the wine is made are grown around the castle Raimat.



Bodegas Bilbainas Viña Pomal Crianza DOC

Bin #704 Bodegas Bilbainas 2013 Tempranillo Rioja, Spain \$38 This deep cherry red wine is full of black fruit and licorice notes, with hints of cocoa and toast from twelve months of aging in American oak barrels. Supple tannins and elegant on the palate.


Estado Natural 'Gran Reserve'

Bin #705 Bodega Familia Sewell 2007 Malbec Mendoza, Argentina \$90 The nose is completely ensconced in woody character adding a solid backbone of black fruit, white cherry, and toast notes settle the palate surrounded by a veil of vanilla and a fresh lengthy finish.



Catena Zapata 'Catena' Malbec

Bin #706 Catena Zapata 2013 Malbec Mendoza, Argentina \$60 Presents a deep violet color with intense aromas, a soft texture, and concentrated flavor. Deep aromas of ripe red and dark fruits are joined by delicate violet and lavender notes, with traces of vanilla and mocha. A rich, concentrated mouthful is highlighted by flavors of blueberries and blackberries with a touch of sweet spice and leather. The wine finishes with bright acidity, well-integrated and silky tannins, and a flinty mineralogy that lingers on the palate.



Salentein Malbec Reserva

Bin #707 Bodegas Salentein 2013 Malbec Mendoza, Argentina \$48 Ruby in color with a lovely nose of black currant, slight cinnamon, and juicy intense flavors of blackberries and marmalade. The flavors are intensified by delicate, rounded tannins, and a finish of vanilla and cloves.



Caligiore Syrah

Bin #708 Caligiore 2009 Syrah Mendoza, Argentina \$38 Of intense violet color, with aromas of spice and red fruit together with notes of vanilla, cinnamon, and cloves, finishing with a fine smokiness. On the palate, we find mature tannins with balanced acidity, that deliver an unctuous and fresh wine.
