Bin #124 Quinta do Monte d'Oiro 2015 Viognier, Arinto Lisboa, Portugal \$39




# Cakebread Cellars Chardonnay

## Blue Valley Chardonnay

Bin #129 Blue Valley Chardonnay 2016 Delaplane Virginia \$44 This predominantly stainless steel aged Chardonnay presents ever so slight aromas of French oak and butterscotch complemented by notes of orchard fruit and a medium-plus body.



### Jordan Chardonnay

Bin #127 Jordan 2015 Chardonnay Russian River Valley, California \$70

"Classic Russian River fruit at its best. Intense aromas of passion fruit, persimmon, and Granny Smith apple leap from the glass, woven with notes of Meyer Lemon, Asian pear and wet-stone minerality. A juicy mid-palate of honeydew melon, fresh guava, and a touch of baking spice is balanced by firm acidity and a creamy mouth feel that carries through the lingering finish.

The lively fruit and vivid backbone of acidity and subtle oak nuances make it sing with lobster or creamy pastas, as well as grilled chicken, fish, or light citrus salads."—wine.com
